Lunchboxes

Please ensure your child's fruit is served appropriately. Grapes should always be quartered lengthwise. Blueberries should be flattened, and raspberries/blackberries should be soft. If they are firm, they should be quartered or squashed. Please remember that when the children eat at Nursery, they are talking to their friends and there are distractions. It is not the same as eating these things in a home environment and it is our job to minimise risk.

Once your child is no longer in the baby room it is difficult for us to cook or heat up food for the children to have for lunch. If you wish to send something hot, please send the food already heated in a small food flask.
